
The concert is six months away, but you need to buy the tickets when they are released, in three months' time, so you don't miss out!

How quickly can you save for the phone?



You will be turning 17 in 6 months and plan to have driving lessons. You hope to pass within 6 months, so have 1 year to save. Will you need more?



You have decided not to go all-inclusive so will need to buy food or eat out. This will cost you around £200 for the week.

Before you drive your car you

need to insure it. This costs £80

per month.

Before you get your car on the road you need to take it to the garage to get its MOT completed (to see if the car is safe to drive).

This costs £50.



#### 5. How?

For your plan you will need to think about how you will earn some money. Discuss the pros and cons of the options below then decide which one is best for you.

You get a job in a supermarket that pays £11 per hour. You will be working 10 hours a week, which takes up most of your weekend.

You get a job in a cafe. This pays £5.28 per hour. You work 8 hours a week, usually on a Sunday.

You decide to save up some of your pocket money. You get £10 a week.

You have limited spare time but have a few hours per week. You decide to babysit for a neighbour once a week for £20.
