*We provide free interactive money workshops which make learning about money simple and fun.*

Our Money Workshops are delivered by external experts with experience in finance and/or teaching, who have been trained by us to make learning about money engaging and relevant for young people. Our Money Workshops are designed for students aged 11 – 19 in schools or colleges and are delivered to classroom sized groups (usually up to 30 students). We offer two standard length of workshop; 60 minutes which allows the workshops to fit in with the school timetable and 100 minutes where we cover topics in more detail and ensure a higher level of understanding. We also offer a half day for KS3 and a full day for KS4.

Our Money Workshops are mapped to the National Curriculum to help teachers bring this vital subject to life.

## Young people

Our workshops follow a modular system which allows teachers to pick and choose the money management topics that are most relevant for their students. Topics focus on the 5 key areas that we believe provide the bedrock of sound money management. This includes:

### *Planning*

- What are your goals and how will you use money to reach them?
- Budgeting – how to draw up a spending plan, needs vs wants and prioritising your spending

### *Saving*

- Saving plans and motivation to save
- Where to save and shopping for a savings account – including an ISA

### *Debt*

- Understanding that not staying on top of your money has consequences
- Knowing what credit is and how to use it wisely

### *Financial products*

- Banking, insurance, mortgages, pensions
- Student Finance

### *Everyday Money*

- Tax and NI
- How to be a savvy consumer & the cost of independent living
- The economy and how it impacts me

Our modular system offers choice and flexibility to schools by offering age/curriculum appropriate workshops which can be delivered as standalone or progressively year on year.

Our workshops are for KS3, KS4 and Post 16 students.
