For 30 years, The Money Charity has been the UK's Financial Capability charity. We proactively provide education, information, advice and guidance to people of all ages, helping them manage their money well and increase their Financial Wellbeing.

In addition to the many challenges facing people from a refugee background and people seeking asylum, they are also confronted with a completely new and complex financial system. This can lead to financial exclusion and increased vulnerability.

In response to this, The Money Charity has developed a Financial Wellbeing programme of five 2-hour Workshops which are fully-funded (free) and available face-to-face or virtually. They are suitable for up to 22 attendees. The sessions can be stand-alone, or organisations may wish to book the whole series.

The Programme Covers The Following Topics:

Introduction to the UK Financial System & Banking

(Financial terms, bank accounts, remittances, payslips, tax & NI)

Budgeting & Saving

(Ways to budget, keep track of your money & save for the future)

Credit & Borrowing

(Sources of credit, informal lending, credit scores & how to manage debt)

Safe Money

(How to identify scams & fraud, support if you have been scammed, staying safe)
